THE PEMBROKE COMPANY OF ARCHERS HEREFORD INVITATION SHOOT

Extreme weather warnings forced cancellation of the original competition arranged for August 10th.

Disappointingly, several of the original entrants were unable to attend the re-arranged date and we were only able to fill seven bosses. This did however give the opportunity to include some of our new Pembroke club members to shoot the shorter Bristol III round.

Ray Harris, the club Chairman, welcomed the competitors and introduced Mr Arwyn Williams, Field Captain and Judge for the day. After the usual preliminary announcements, shooting commenced on time and progressed throughout in the relaxed and friendly atmosphere that has become a trademark of this competition.

Ladies, Gents and Juniors shot in the four recognised GNAS tournament bow styles of Recurve, Barebow, Longbow and Compound Unlimited. Both the rounds consist of a total of 12 dozen arrows, at three different decreasing distances, (Hereford: 80yards, 60 yards and 50 yards – Bristol III; 50 yards, 40 yards and 30 yards). Ends of 6 arrows are then shot, scored and collected.

The weather was good on this occasion; warm with a light breeze and sunshine throughout the shoot.

Trophies and medals were presented at the end of the day by the Club Chairman.

Of particular note were:-

Peter Morgan, (Pembroke C of A), who won the Gents Recurve category for the second year running, adding on this occasion the Overall Recurve Trophy.

Stephan Williams, (Cymric Archers), shooting the under 14 Compound Unlimited bow category, won the Junior Trophy with an excellent score, also claiming a Dyfed Archery Association county record.

Ray thanked Arwyn, (assisted by Club Field Captain Dave Cochlin), for running the competition smoothly and in good order throughout the day, all who attended, those who donated the ever popular raffle prizes, helped with scoring, target moving and the final clear up.

Thanks also go to Sue Brown for checking and collating the scores for the result and Nikki for making sure no one escaped without purchasing raffle tickets!

The well presented and set out field was a credit to the work of Ray Harris put in over the days leading up to the shoot, (twice!), and club members who assisted where possible and on the day to set up.
