## THE PEMBROKE COMPANY OF ARCHERS HEREFORD INVITATION SHOOT

The 2010 Hereford Invitation Shoot again proved a popular event for the Dyfed County archers. The usual target space of seven 80 yard bosses was filled and a shorter boss, at 50 yards, was added to accommodate some junior archers, giving a full field on the day.

Ladies, Gents and Juniors shot in the four recognised GNAS tournament bow styles of Recurve, Barebow, Longbow and Compound Unlimited. There were no cancellations, all present in good time for an early start. The weather was fine and warm, with sunshine and little wind. Exactly as forecast and excellent for archery. Dave Hall, our club Chairman, controlled the shooting, supported at the target, by club Field Captain, Dave Cochlin, to ensure that the competition ran smoothly and to time.

As usual there was some excellent shooting several archers shooting personal best scores.

Jon Thornhill (Independent & DAA) retained the Gents Recurve trophy with Paul Hoad, (Castle Archers), taking the silver medal and Dave Cochlin, (Pembroke C of A), the bronze.

Reinair Kalmaru, (Castle Archers), won the Gents Barebow gold medal with a new County Record score of 943. Hywel Bowen took the silver medal, (also exceeding the existing County Record score), with 915. Marek Pawlic won the bronze with 801.

Sian Richardson (Fort Archers) won the Barebow Lady gold, with Sue Brown, (Pembroke C of A), second.

Fort Archers had a clean sweep of the Compound Unlimited class. Jeremy Phillips won the gold medal, with a personal best score of 1270 and an all time best score for this Hereford Invitation Shoot. Warren Codd won the silver medal and Andrew Watts the bronze.

Jeremy's score was only 26 points less than the maximum of 1296 – 131 golds scored from a possible 144!

Stuart Edwards, shooting longbow, exceeded his existing county record score with a new claim of 488.

Ben Simpson, (Pembroke) and Jessica Davis (Cymric) shot the Bristol III round at 50, 40 and 30 yards. Both exceeded the Junior Master Bowman scores for their age groups, Ben with a personal best of 1046 and Jessica, (shooting above her usual distance), scored 987 to claim for a new county record - also achieving the "best gold at the longest distance" of all the competitors.

Nathan Abrams, of Pembroke, at 16 now in the under 18 age group shot the Bristol I round, starting at 80 yards. A junior bowman in his previous age groups, Nathan recorded a first class score of 736, confirming his ability to compete at the highest junior level.

The three scores which, subject to verification, appear to be good Dyfed County record claims are: -

Reinair Kalmaru (Castle Archers) - Gents Barebow 943  
Stuart Edwards (Pembroke C of A) - Gents Longbow 488  
Jessica Davis (Cymric Archers) - Junior Lady Under 14 Recurve 987

The club are pleased to thank all members who helped in preparation for the event, Ray Harris for tree cutting and marking the field and Jenny Thornhill for collecting, scores and, most importantly, selling the raffle tickets!

Finally thanks to all who attended and helped make the day an enjoyable shoot for everyone, those who donated some superb raffle prizes, helped with scoring, target moving and final clearing away of all equipment.
